**Work Complete**

The project is slated to begin in summer of 2017 at this time the project is in design proposal phase.

Scope of project (**LaSalle Avenue to Cook Avenue**)

**Work will include:**

- Roadway Resurfacing
- Replacement of non-compliant American Disability Act
- Ramps, driveways, and sidewalk replacement
- Full signal replacement (**intersection upgrades at Belair Road and Frankford**)
- Replacement of damaged curb and gutters
- Some bump-outs, bus shelter/bus pads
- Convert existing street lights fixtures to city approved LED lights
- Pedestrian lighting, street amenities including (**benches, trash cans, and bike racks**)
- Install decorative crosswalk,
- (**Replace existing parking coin meter with EZ parking meters**)
- Trees, Landscaping/tree pits
- Replace existing bike markings/signage

**The intersections improvements at Echodale Avenue, Cook Ave, Cook-Frankford, & LaSalle Avenue.** (Will be ADA ramp improvements, crosswalk enhancements only)

\*Cost of project is estimated at \$2 million 80% Federal money/20% Local

\*Estimated the **design Process** will be completed in fall 2016/ **Construction Started Summer 2017**
